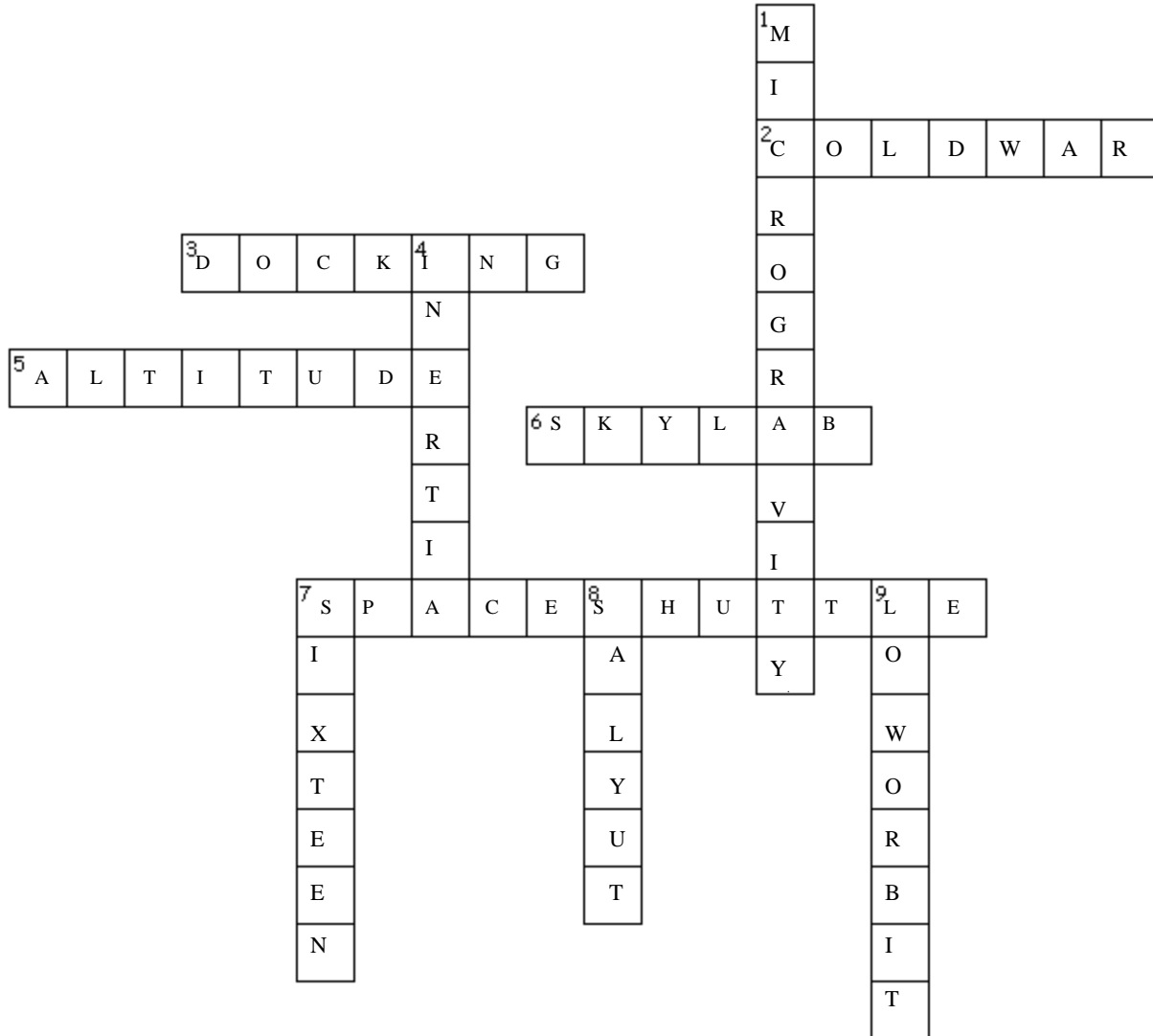


International Space Station
